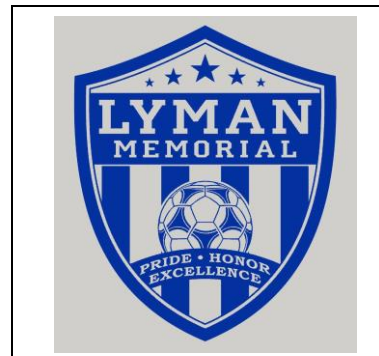

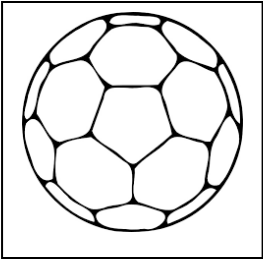

Disclaimer

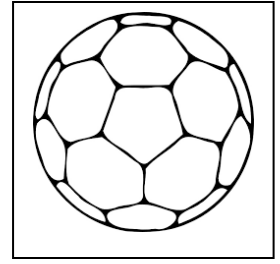

Entering its 20th year, the Lyman Soccer Camp combines challenging instruction, an experienced coaching staff and excellent competition to create an exciting youth summer soccer camp experience and is a true soccer training camp for girls and boys of all abilities. Our combination of actual game situations, and the development and refinement of fundamentals produces skilled, creative and versatile soccer players.

Our staff coaches with expertise, enthusiasm and positive attitudes, all resulting in each participant leaving camp a better soccer player, teammate and individual. Our philosophy is that soccer camp should be both educational and fun! Soccer camp coaches include past & present Lyman Memorial stand out players and reputable, certified and licensed local area soccer coaches. The week culminates in contests complete with prizes, trophies and medals.

Beginning players will develop individual and fundamental skill techniques and a passion for the game, which is the main focus of our camp. Campers are exposed to the fundamentals of soccer using the "games approach" to teaching. Multiple small-sided games are utilized to give players the ability to practice what they have learned in a game-like situation.

Advanced Campers will refine individual skill techniques and be exposed to the major tactical aspects of the game. In this soccer environment, advanced players will perform technical work under pressure and proper tactical decision making is taught, in both training and game environments. Drill work emphasizing mastery of the fundamentals of the game will continued to be stressed. Former Lyman Memorial All-State and All-New England and current/former collegiate players, US Soccer Developmental Academy players and licensed high school and premier soccer coaches will be training those in the speed/foot skills/finishing and goalkeeping extended camp. Goalkeeping instruction at the camp is by *Make the Save Goalkeeping Academy* is incredibly reputable, specialized and unique.

Soccer Camp Director - Ryan Fabry

Coach Ryan Fabry is entering his 20th season as Lyman Memorial High School Boys Varsity Soccer Head Coach and 26th overall as a high school soccer coach. His career record at Lyman is 232-82-40 (.712). He has coached Lyman to its first ever 2003 C.O.C title, first E.C.C. Tournament Championship in 2018, eight E.C.C Regular Season Division championships - 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2015, 2016 & 2018 and the school's first ever Class 'S' State Championship in 2002 with subsequent state final appearances in 2003 & 2009. His coaching highlights include being named the 2011 Connecticut's High School Coaches' Association Boys Soccer State Coach of the Year, the 2007 Connecticut Soccer Coaches Association State Coach of the Year, the 2002, 2007 & 2016 Norwich Bulletin and 2007 & 2009 The New London Day Boys Soccer Coach of the Year, the 2006, 2007, 2009, 2010, 2015, 2016, & 2018 Eastern Connecticut Conference Division Coach of the Year, and the 2003 Charter Oak Conference Boys Soccer Coach of the Year. He is a USSF, USCA, CJSA and state of CT licensed soccer coach and currently an active member of the USCA & the CSCA. He is a former varsity goalkeeper for Western New England University (1989-90) and an All-E.C.C. and Class 'L' All-State player for Ledyard High School.
